Folio in rag, official stamped paper, with revalidation stamp for 1761 and 1762, italic handwriting. On the recto side has a header with official stamped paper registration: "Un Real (One Real)", under the seal of Charles III, on the side, inscription: "SELLO TERCERO, UN REAL, AÑO DE MIL SETECIENTOS Y CINQVENTA Y SEIS Y CINQVENTA Y SIETE" ("SEAL THIRD, ONE REAL, YEAR ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY SIX AND FIFTY SEVEN"); underneath, the revalidation of the sealed paper: "VALGA PARA EL REYN. DE S.M. EL S. D. CARLOS III EN LOS AÑOS DE 1761, Y 1762" ("Valid for the Reign of His Majesty, the Lord Carlos III, in the years 1761 to 1762"); to the right side, it shows a particular sign in ink. The initial protocol, refers to the identification of the notary giving bona fide to the deed. The body of the document describes the context of the death of the Illustrious Doctor Don Diego del Corro, Archbishop of Lima, in the town of San Jerónimo, province of Jauja, in Junín. On the verso side, we can see the printing of the deeds. The state of conservation of the document is bad, with characteristics of belonging to a complex unit (book, protocol or file); it presents humidity stains in all the support, wrinkles, folds; the writing in ink shows loss of color and oxidation.

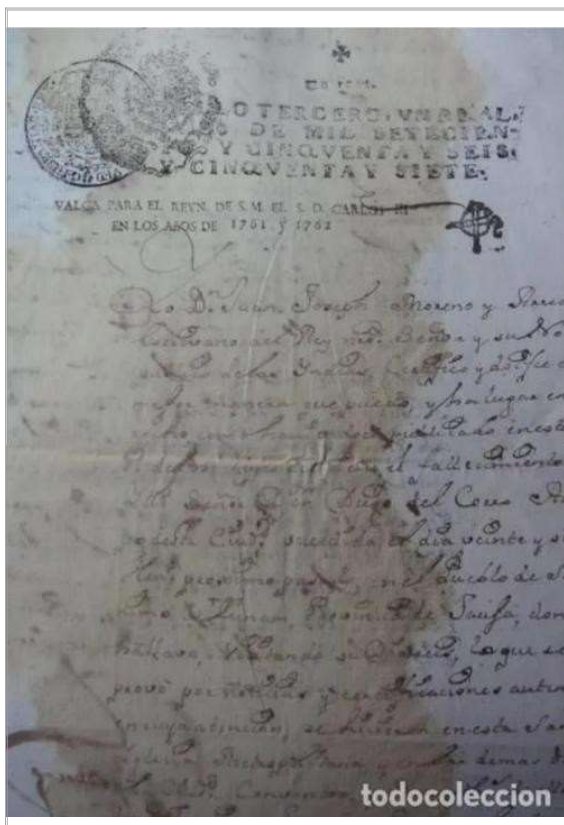


Image: View of recto page.

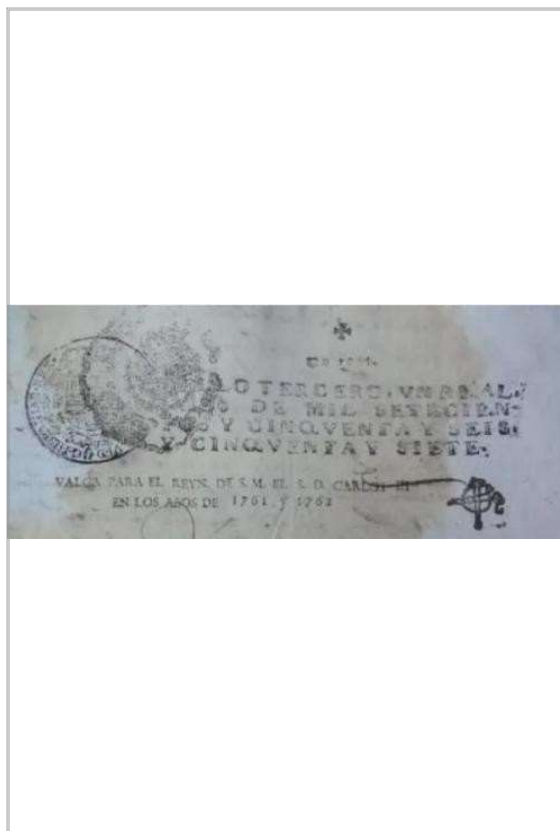


Image: Detail of official stamped paper.



Image: Stamp detail, original and revalidated.

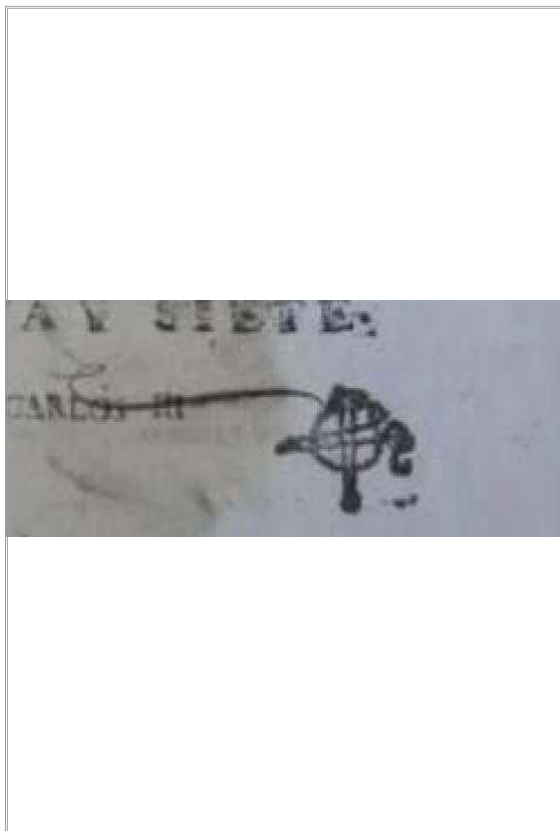


Image: Detail of notary's signature.
